- ➤ Ken S. from Wausau suggested a new way to determine tie score winners. He suggested using the long run from the front, on the total score of 50 targets to determine winners. This would replace coin flip, draw cards, name draw. This would be for class winners (except Championship Shoot) and Lewis money winners. After discussion a motion was made and seconded to adopt this new rule for determining tie scores.
