GENERAL SHOOT INFORMATION

The WSSA cordially invites all Wisconsin shooters to the 94th Wisconsin State Skeet Championships hosted by Brown County Sportsmen's Club on Aug. 29-31, 2025. Advance RESERVATIONS are REQUIRED to ensure preferred shooting times. The reservation form is provided with this flyer. Please return reservations and squad requests to Paul Friesen.

The Wisconsin Skeet Championships are open to all NSSA members (the Tournament is an OPEN SHOOT). Membership to the WSSA (\$10 annual fee payable at registration) is required at the start of the shoot for eligibility for WI State titles, awards, and purses from the WSSA. Non-WSSA and out-of-state competitors are eligible for shoot purses but not WSSA titles, awards, or WSSA-added purse money or prizes.

It is the RESPONSIBILITY of each shooter to update their Shoot Record (scores, averages, and class) to present it upon registration. In the absence of a properly completed Shoot Record, a shooter may be assigned to Class AA by the Classification Committee. The shooter's average is that at their last classification. *All competitors are asked to register and be ready to shoot at their assigned field 15 min prior to their flight time.*

SHELLS and SHOOT-OFFS

Reloads may be used, subject to inspection per NSSA rules. A limited supply of shells for the competition will be available at the Club. Winners among those with tie scores will be determined by shoot-offs, which will be conducted after the last flight of the day:

- 1) Shoot-offs will consist of doubles from 3-4-5-4-3-etc. by "miss-&-out by station" (NSSA Rules) in the order of Champ, RU, Class 1, Class 2, Class 3, Concurrents, and Teams.
- 2) Team event shoot-offs will be determined by "last one standing."

WSSA Directors in conjunction with the SPT&S shoot management reserve the right to change the shoot program when warranted. The competition will follow NSSA rules.
